aspirations	A hope or ambition of achieving something.

data protection	Trusting people to use your information fairly and responsibly.
influence	Having an effect on the character or behaviour of someone/ something.
job	A paid position of regular employment.
social media	Websites and apps that allow users to create and share content/ participate with others online.
stereotype	A fixed idea that many people have about a thing/ group/ that may be untrue or only partly true.
