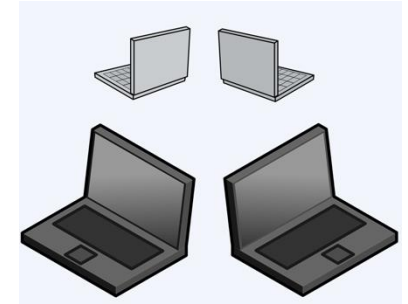

Word	Definition
Frame	A single image in a sequence of pictures.
Angles	The specific placement of a camera to achieve different images.
Video	The recording of moving visual images.
Audio	Sound, especially when recorded, transmitted, or reproduced.
Camera	A device for recording visual images.
Talking head	A presenter who addresses the camera.
Panning	Moving a camera horizontally whilst keeping the base still.
