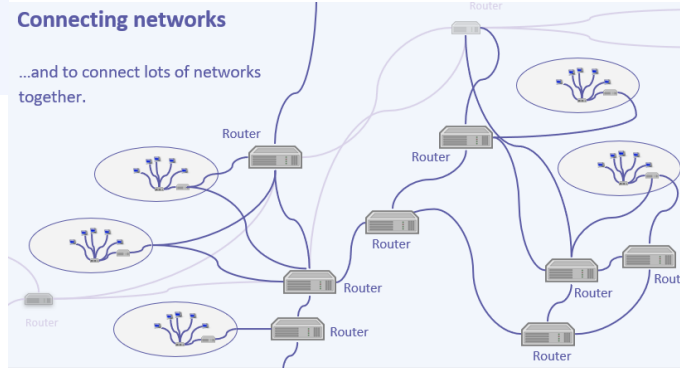
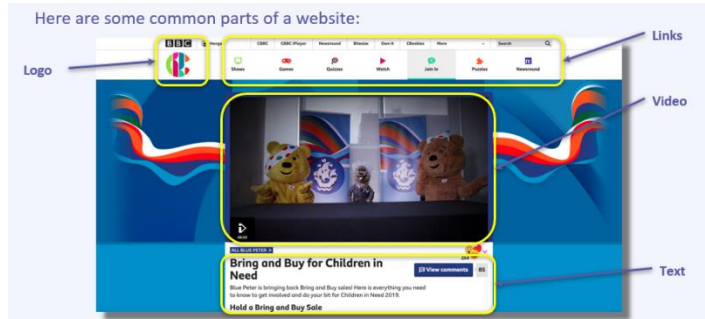

Word	Definition
WWW	The world wide web.
Unreliable material	The low probability that a system will perform what it needs to perform.
Content	Written text on an email, web page or on a file.
Website	Web pages which have the same domain name.
Internet	A global computer network which has a variety of information.
Network	A group of interconnected systems on the internet.
