Another busy week has passed by at Winsford High Street and it has been lovely to see the children hard at work across the school.

Change of Leadership Structure

I write to inform you of a change to the Leadership Structure at Winsford High Street Community Primary School from January 2025.

After 21 years as Head teacher of the school I will be reducing my working commitment to 3 days each week to enable me to pursue other projects. This will be similar to a number of years ago when I was working as a part time Educational Advisor for the Local Authority, supporting local schools in the area.

To ensure the continued smooth running of the school, the Governors have created the new position of 'Head of School' to sit under that of the Part time Head teacher. Mrs Robbins has been appointed to this role and will be responsible for the day to day running of the school, when I am not in school. She will be supported by the Senior Leadership Team on a daily basis:

I am sure that you will join with me in congratulating Mrs Robbins on her appointment. Rest assured I will continue to give my all to support the children of Winsford High Street.

Girl's Football



On Tuesday 26th November, eight of our Year 5 and 6 girls travelled to Shavington for the Girls U11 6 A-Side Competition and Crewe Alexandra's football centre. After an early start to the day, the girls were ready and raring to go and started the tournament brilliantly with a comfortable 2-0 win. The girls continued in fine form, winning the next game 1-0, although we could easily have scored 4 or 5 had it not been for the posts, crossbar or the opposing goalkeeper which seemed to act as a magnet to High Street's shots. The third game of the groups saw a highly anticipated match against The Quinta (who had won the competition the previous year). The girls matched a talented team from The Quinta and had chances to win. Unfortunately, two well finished goals meant we were beaten 2-0. To their credit, the girls never gave up and were incredibly positive throughout the day. After this defeat, we won our three remaining group matches 2-0, 1-0 and 6-0 respectively, gualifying for the guarter finals against Monks Coppenhall.
