Please can all parents log into school gateway weekly to pick your child/children's hot school meals if required. Just to make you aware that the 'Dietary meal' option is only available for children with food allergies that are known to us. If your child has a food allergy we will require a medical note from their Doctor or Paediatrician which is then confirmed with Edsential, our schools catering company. Dogstrust Assemblies

As part of our PHSE curriculum we have booked assemblies and workshops with Dogstrust who run dog safety workshops to help pupils behave in a safe and kind way towards dogs they know by learning the ABCs of being a dog's best friend!

The ABCs help pupils understand how to:

-show dogs affection in ways they understand

-give dogs space when they are busy -give dogs choice in every interaction

-recognise dog body language and key signals (only included in workshops for pupils aged 9 - 11).

TIKTOK/E-Safety

Did you know that the recommended age group for children to access TIKTOK is 13 years, and some features are also restricted to over 18s only. A parent/carer guide to TIKTOK will also be shared via Dojo along with a guide to setting up parent controls. Please take some time to read this information to keep you informed of the risks when children are accessing TIKTOK, it also has some advice for you to follow for home.

Keeping safe when using on-line apps is a key part of our e-safety curriculum in school to support children accessing and using apps in school and at home. The children are taught that the age restriction on an app shows how old you need to be to access the content.
