School Closure

Thank you for your understanding regards the enforced closure of the school on Monday due to issues with the power supply. What the issue identified was that some parents do not have the DOJO App. Please note that this is the main route for communication in such instances and we strongly encourage you to download the app should you have not already.

School gateway meal choices

Please can <u>all</u> parents log into school gateway weekly to pick your child/children's hot school meals if required. Just to make you aware that the 'Dietary meal' option is only available for children with food allergies that are known to us. If your child has a food allergy, we will require a medical note from their Doctor or Paediatrician which is then confirmed with Edsential, our schools catering company. If you need to discuss this further, please contact the office.

It is the policy of Edsential Catering to provide the <u>children arriving late to school</u> who have not chosen their option, of a meal of whatever has been made as an extra. They won't guarantee providing a meal of choice in such instances.
