WhatsApp

Sadly, we have been dealing with a number of online incidents where children have been using WhatsApp inappropriately at home and the school are having to deal with the impact of this. Please can we remind all parents that social media has age restrictions for a reason, this being that the children under the given ages are not deemed to be mature enough to use the platform. This we are finding to be the case with the indiscretions that are brought to our attention. If the device your child is using to send messages is registered in your name, then you will be the first point of contact if it is reported to the police.

Data System

Over the next few weeks, we will be moving to a new management information database, known as "**Arbor**". This system is used in lots of schools across the UK and provides a one-stop portal for information on your child and bookings and payments.

As part of this move, we will be changing our online payments and booking system and we are hopeful that we will be able to roll all of this out to you shortly after the return from the Easter holiday. Please bear with us for a few days after our return as the transfer may take a little time. Until then, you can continue to use the current School Gateway system. We will continue to use Class Dojo as the main form of communication.

Book Fair

Thank you very much to everyone for attending our Book Fair a couple of weeks ago, it was wonderful to see the children so engaged and excited with the books. We sold a whopping £680 worth of books throughout the four days we were open and now have over £400 worth of commission (this is inclusive of last year's commission too) to spend on new books for the school.
