## Key Enquiry Questions:

### **What are rules and why are they important?**

## Key Vocabulary:

<b>community</b>	A group of people living in the same place.
<b>needs</b>	Something you need to survive.
<b>strengths</b>	Something you're particularly good at.
<b>jobs</b>	A role that someone carries out.
<b>responsibility</b> (in the context of caring for something e.g. a pet).	To understand that it is our role to care for living things such as pets (if we have them) to keep them safe and healthy.
