### Know how to:

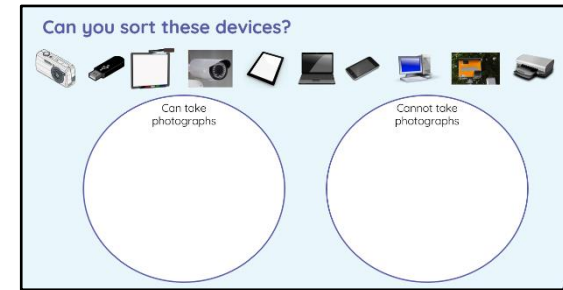
- Use a digital device to take a photograph

Word	Definition
<b>Photograph</b>	A <b>photograph</b> is an image, or picture, that has been captured on film or some other material.
<b>Capture</b>	Recording an image, sound, or other information using a computer or camera, or the image or other information that is recorded
<b>Landscape</b>	Holding the device sideways
<b>Portrait</b>	Holding the device upright
<b>Tools</b>	Features on a program that allow you makes changes/edit.
<b>Editing</b>	Adjust a photograph.
<b>Improve</b>	To make changes and make something better.
